

To Register Your Aircraft as a Light Sport Aircraft (LSA)

1	Reserve your "N" number (\$10)	http://www.faa.gov/licenses_certificates/aircraft_certification/aircraft_registry/special_nnumbers/
2	Register your aircraft with the FAA (\$5)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Send Form 8050-1 - Aircraft Registration * Send Form 8050-88A - Affidavit of Ownership
3	Receive FAA Registration Form (8050-3)	Your aircraft is now registered, but you cannot fly it until it has an Airworthiness Inspection
4	Call MIDO for Airworthiness Inspection	Paul Horridge, 781-238-7127. MIDO will inform Portland FSDO to arrange for the inspection
5	Contact Portland FSDO (Flight Standards District Office) for inspection date	207-780-3263 - ask for Airworthiness Inspections
6	Send to FSDO all paperwork	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Form 8130-6 - Application for Airworthiness Certificate * Form Letter * Picture of aircraft * Powered Parachute Weight & Loading Form * Condition Inspection Form
7	FSDO Inspector inspects your aircraft	Receive Form FAA Form 8130-7 - Special Airworthiness Certificate, and Operating Limitations letter
